Equitable Access to Success Evaluation (EASE) Workgroup

• Workgroup providing evaluation updates with considerations for continuous quality improvement addressing Standard II.C.3 to the Accreditation Steering Committee.

Standard II.C.3: The institution assures equitable access to all of its students by providing appropriate, comprehensive, and reliable services to students regardless of service location or delivery method.

- Members are people who have direct experience with students at the Centers. Tri-chairs: senior administrator for Student Affairs plus Classified and Faculty members elected by vote of the workgroup.
- EASE Core Services: (1) Admissions & Records, (2) Academic Counseling including DSPS, (3) Financial Aid, (4) Library and Learning Resources/Tutoring, (5) Access to Course materials/Bookstore, (6) Co-curricular Activities and Student Government, (7) Access to Complaints and Grievances, Students Rights & Responsibilities, and Student Conduct
- Centers currently offering in-person classes: Chinatown/North Beach, Downtown, Evans, John Adams, Mission



EASE evaluation 2022 - 23 elements

- Self-reflection by Center deans and services leads Fall 2022
 For each core service:
 - Necessary components to provide effective and equitable services: How services are being provided (on site and virtual).
 - Challenges to providing services for students at the Center.
- Site visits Spring 2023
 - Collaboratively organized by EASE lead and Center dean
 - In person site tour (1 hour) and hybrid discussion (1 hour)
 - Evaluation tool provided to all participants
 - Observations collected via online form

EASE evaluation remaining activities

- 1. Site visits to Evans, Mission, and Downtown Centers
- 2. After each site visit, EASE visiting group lead drafts summary of participant observations (e.g., see <u>John Adams</u>; <u>Chinatown/North Beach</u>)
- 3. Once all site visits are complete, EASE Workgroup assisted by ORP will:
 - 1. Identify themes what's going well, key areas of focus for improvement
 - 2. Develop EASE Evaluation 2022-2023 report
 - 3. Present report to Accreditation Steering Committee in Fall 2023
- 4. Along the way, EASE Workgroup will reflect on site visit process, what works well, what could be improved
